- 1. Douglas Fir Log post & beam design throughout home with large custom scissor trusses. Log Diameters up to 26". (\$100+K cost)
- 2. Douglas fir siding all around exterior and 3" by 6" thick Douglas fir door and window trim (\$30+K cost)
- 3. Panoramic South facing views of Keystone, Mt Baldy, 6 & 7<sup>th</sup> holes at the Raven Golf Course & Ruby Ranch
- 4. Great room with 25 foot ceilings and expansive south facing walls of windows
- 5. Walk-in (drive-in) to main floor with easy access to kitchen storage & main floor master suite
- 6. Full walkout lower level with 10-foot ceiling (2 French doors & sliding door)
